It is a great opportunity to transfer the Biblical values concerning human being, integrity, freedom, democracy, etc.... I wish that I have taught philosophy since the beginning of the school.

MEDICINAL MADAGASCAR PLANTS

Clara was so blessed attending ANAMED a week long training in Natural Medicine.

She learnt many things, in depth Artemisia annua, and its use to treat malaria and to strengthen the immune system of AIDS patients. She set up a small local team and they started making a medicinal garden, with contours and leguminous hedges.



The small team prepare together compost and all kind of medicinal plants seeds to be planted. They also prepare teas, oils, ointments and other medicines from herbs.

Clara start to use them to treat patients. And it sounds that they are so effective.
